Dear District 95 Community:

Through these cold months, progress on both our short and long term solutions to address enrollment increases continue. In our work to get modular classrooms ready for the 15-16 school year, we need to work through two specific processes.

First, the Village of La Grange Park is requiring the District to participate in a Site Review Process. The appropriate materials have been submitted, and I anticipate being on the Village's March 17 agenda. In order to bring even greater transparency to the process, the District will be hosting a parent forum on **MONDAY, MARCH 9 at Brook Park School at 7:00pm**. The purpose of this meeting is to describe the work to date on the District's projects and allow community to answer questions about the Modular Units.

Second, we are required to comply with a much more stringent requirement for water retention than in the past. The new code enacted some 9 months ago, does require a permit from the MWRD. The civil engineers have completed the necessary work to submit materials for the permit. The permit should be in the hands of the MWRD by Mid March.

Although these processes create additional work on behalf of the District, they are a necessary exercise to reach our end goal. I have every confidence that we will successfully navigate each process and that the time-line for installing our modular units will not be impacted.

Again, I hope that you may join me on March 9 at Brook Park School at 7:00 to allow me to answer any questions you may have about our projects as well as hear the latest information on the status of our projects.
